**HALF TERM PLAYScheme PROGRAMME:** Once again, Enfield Council are offering playschemes across the borough during half term. Closed access sessions cover arts, crafts, games and sports and run daily from Monday to Friday at £16.00 per day. All places must be booked in advance. Open access adventure is offered at Florence Hayes Playground for 8-16 year old children. This will be supervised but is free - please provide a packed lunch if your child is staying all day.

**SCHOOL SECURITY/LATE ARRIVALS:** If your child arrives late at school in the morning—i.e. after 08.55 hrs - they need to register at the Welfare Office and receive a red slip which informs the classteacher that they have registered as late and will avoid you receiving a telephone call from us. **Parents do not need to accompany their child to the Welfare Room** as this creates congestion and a security risk, as we do not permit parents in after the gates have closed.
