BLACK HISTORY MONTH: Throughout October we were covering Black History Month with activities focused on the Olympics and past Olympic heroes and athletes. We have held several special assemblies and have invited speakers into school to talk to the children.

HARVEST FESTIVAL.GARDEN DAY: Thank you to all those parents and carers who attended our Harvest Festival on 20th October. Later in the day, the children were each able to plant a bulb on the school field during our Garden Day. This is part of our 2012 Olympic celebration—which will, we hope, next year see the bulbs grow into the shape of the international Olympic rings.

CASHLESS: Our transition to Cashless for lunches went very smoothly during the final week of last term and many thanks to all those parents who had opened their accounts well in advance. PARENTS SUPPORT ADVISOR: Mrs Hassan is available each Thursday morning from **9.15—9.45 a.m.** in the Coaching Room to offer help, advice and assistance on any school issues that you may wish to discuss. Tea and toast will be on offer so please do drop in if you have any queries.



BREAKFAST CLUB: Our Breakfast Club is open to children from Years Reception to Year 6 from 8.00 a.m. every day, at £1.00 per child per session, payable in advance. We provide toast and jam, cereal, juices, etc as well as the opportunity for your child to participate in supervised games before going to class. You do not need to book—just turn up and pay on the day.

AFTER SCHOOL CLUB: There are spaces available in our After School Club, but you do need to reserve a place for your child. The Club runs daily during term time from 3.15—5.45 p.m. and costs £7.00 per child per session if attending 5 days a week. If you would like your child to attend four or less days a week, it will be £8.00 per child per session. Discounts of £1 per child are available for a second or third child in one for family group. Please pay weekly in advance. Children must be at least five years of age. Again, please contact the School Office for further details.
