OPEN EVENINGS: It was good to see so many parents around the School for our recent Open Evenings—if you did not have an opportunity to speak to your child's teacher at that time, please make an appointment for a later date. Thank you very much to everyone who visited our **Book Fair**—we raised almost £1,103 during the course of the week—65% of which the school will receive in commission by way of books for our Library.

CASHLESS: As you know our Cashless lunch payment system will be introduced on **Monday, 17th October**. After this date all payments will need to be carried out on line. You have by now received your child's account details, so please if you have not yet done so, log-on to the Parentpay website and access your details in order to credit your account at least a week in advance. If you have any questions please ask at the office before the start of the new system.

BREAKFAST CLUB: Our Breakfast Club is open to children from Years Reception to Year 6 from 8.00 a.m. every day, at £1.00 per child per session, payable in advance. We provide toast and jam, cereal, juices, etc as well as the opportunity for your child to participate in supervised games before going to class. You do not need to book—just turn up and pay on the day.

AFTER SCHOOL CLUB: There are spaces available in our After School Club, but you do need to reserve a place for your child. The Club runs daily during term time from 3.15—5.45 p.m. and costs £7.00 per child per session if attending 5 days a week. If you would like your child to attend four or less days a week, it will be £8.00 per child per session. Discounts of £1 per child are available for a second or third child in one for family group. Please pay weekly in advance. Again, please contact the School Office for further details.
